## **CIRCULAR**

Anna University has signed thirty seven MoUs till now with various universities / Institutions across the globe. Students interested in pursuing their studies for a semester or two as exchange students and students interested in going for a short duration for internship can visit the sites of our partner institutions & look for avenues of interest. Faculty can also look for opportunities for research and for exchange of knowhow with these institutions. Once contact is established with experts in your fields of interest, then bilateral cooperation will become easy and will be beneficial for both the partners.

Students who are interested should be able to mobilize financial support. Those who are interested should get prior approval from the University before proceeding on their trip to study abroad.

The following have to be done to start the mobility:

- Anna University have MoUs with other institutions, abroad. The abroad institutions will waive the tuition fee. However, the travel and living expenses should be met out by the student.
- The courses to be studied at the host institution shall match with the courses offered in Anna University as far as possible.
- The relevant documents such as, acceptance letter from the host institution, details of courses to be studied, recommendation of HOD, etc, have to be sent to the Centre for International Affairs through proper channel for approval from the Centre for Academic Courses.
- A Learning Agreement must be signed between Anna University & Host institution before finalizing the departure.
